

CPMCA Scholarship Guidelines

We are proud to offer the CPMCA Scholarship Program, which offers students generous financial support each year. The program is established to award a student one (1) scholarship for the upcoming 2024-2025 school year. The recipient can receive \$2,500; subject to verification that the student meets the minimum requirements delineated below.

The scholarship is offered to students who demonstrate exceptional academic and extracurricular achievement. The CPMCA Scholarship will be awarded based on personal information, GPA, SAT, college plans, and an essay.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for selection the applicant must be either: (1) a **current employee** at a CPMCA Contractor Member company working a minimum of sixteen hours each week for a minimum of three months prior to the scholarship submittal deadline or (2) a **child, grandchild or sibling** of any employee (office or field personnel) or owner working for a CPMCA Contractor Member company in Southern California.

To be eligible for the scholarship the candidate must be awaiting acceptance, accepted by or currently attending a two (2) or four (4) year accredited college or university as a full-time student (a minimum of 12 units).

Minimum academic requirements to be considered for the CPMCA Scholarship is a “B” average (2.7 GPA or higher) and proof of enrollment at a two (2) or four (4)-year college or university.

Scholarships are awarded by the CPMCA Scholarship Committee.

1. The CPMCA Contractor Member **must** complete a Member Company Qualification Statement certifying that the applicant is affiliated with the company and therefore eligible to apply.
2. The student applicant must complete the application form, along with the requested essay. **Essays should be no more than three (3) TYPEWRITTEN double-spaced pages.** Essays will be judged on content and clarity. The committee will focus on content rather than style and grammar; however, the applicant should understand the importance of written communication in the mechanical contracting industry.
